Articles of Incorporation

OF

Willamette-Salem Chapter of the Experimental Aircraft Association

The undersigned, acting as incorporators under the Oregon Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is Willamette-Salem Chapter, Experimental Aircraft Association

and its duration shall be perpetual

ARTICLE II

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

The corporation may engage in any lawful activity for which corporations may be organized under ORS Chapter 61.

ARTICLE III

ARTICLE IV

It is sufficient to state, either alone or with other purposes, "That the corporation may engage in any lawful activity for which corporations may be organized under ORS Chapter 61"; however, it may be desirable to state the primary purpose of the corporation in conjunction with such statement if used.
